TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EXECUTION OF INSULATION OF BARNs
- WITH PADDY STRAW

1. The execution of work of insulation of tobacco curing barns will be at the farmer's site at the village identified by the Auction Superintendents.
2. The list of the eligible farmers whose barns are to be insulated shall be obtained from the Auction Superintendents concerned at the Auction Platforms.
3. Care and maintenance of the labourers rest with the successful tenderers only.
4. Insulation of barn shall be executed in presence of the farmer or his representative. Consent letter is to be obtained from the respective farmer only before commencing the work by the FA/FO/SGO/AS of respective auction platforms, Tobacco Board at the time of collection of indent/at the time of registration of growers. Copies of such certificates have to be made available to the successful tenderer by the concerned auction platform Auction Superintendents along with village wise list of barns to be insulated/allocated to the said tenderer. The successful tenderer will invariably obtain the completion certificate from the barn owner confirming satisfactory completion through Tobacco Board.
5. The tenderer shall use the material for execution as prescribed without any deviation.
6. Payment will be made at the respective Auction Platforms on production of Bill along with the consent letter and completion certificate obtained from the respective farmer only at the time of execution of the work. Payment will not be made without consent letter and completion certificate from the respective farmer only. The tenderers will invariably submit the cost of each item mentioned in point.6 of the tender application form.
7. The latest copy of statement of income tax returns may be enclosed without fail along with PAN number. A photocopy of the PAN card may also be enclosed.
8. Wherever, the tenderer downloads the tender application form from the Tobacco Board website, a DD for Rs.520/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore alongwith tender forms should be submitted.
9. The tenderer shall submit a DD for Rs.20,000/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore towards EMD and submit the same along with tender form.
10. Successful tenderer is required to submit a DD for Rs.50,000/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore towards security deposit for giving work order by the Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore.

11. Application without EMD will summarily be rejected.
12. The EMD and security deposit will not carry any interest and will be returned only after completion of execution of work by the successful tenderer.
13. The EMD and security deposit will be forfeited if the work of the successful tenderer is not satisfactory.
14. The EMD amount will be returned to the un-successful tenderers through post to the address mentioned in the tender application.
15. The finalized price of each unit will be in force for a period of one year from the date of work order.
16. One or more agencies may be awarded the work for expeditious completion. In case, work is found slow in respect of a selected agency.
17. Wherever the paddy straw is supplied by the barn owner for insulating his barn. The cost of the same will be deducted at the time of making payment to the successful tenderer.
18. The agency also shall submit a statement of list of barns size wise with name of the grower, TBGR/TB Nos. of the concerned barns village wise in the concerned auction platforms, on completion to Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore.
19. The successful tenderer will have to transport the required insulation material to the barn site at his own cost. The Board is not responsible for any loss of items during transit or at barn site.
20. The tenderers shall submit a separate tender form for roof insulation of barns and same shall be dropped in the tender box kept at Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore before 3 P.M. on 30.5.08. Tenders will be opened at 4 P.M on the same day in the presence of tenderers.
21. The list of barns village wise/auction platform wise be available with Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore.
22. The work relating to insulation of barns is required to be carried in the jurisdiction of auction platforms, H.D.Kote, Hunsur-I & II, Periyapatna-IV, V &VI, Kamplapura – I &II in the Mysore district and Ramanathpura I&II in Hassan district.
23. The Chairman, Tobacco Board has every right to reject any/all tenders without assigning any reasons.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INSTALLATION OF VENTURY FURNACE
-IN THE BARNS

1. The installation of ventury furnaces to the tobacco curing barns will at the farmer's site at the villages identified by the Auction Superintendents.
2. The list of the eligible farmers whose barns are to be insulated shall be obtained from the Auction Superintendent concerned at the auction platform.
3. Care and maintenance of the labourers rest with the successful tenderers only.
4. Installation of the ventury furnaces shall be executed in presence of the farmer only. Consent letter is to be obtained from the respective farmer/his representative before commencing the work by the Auction Superintendents of respective auction platforms of Tobacco Board at the time of collection of indent/at the time of registration of growers. Copies of such certificates will be made available to the successful tenderer by the concerned auction platforms along with village wise list of barns to be installed to the successful tenderer. The successful tenderer will invariably obtain the completion certificate from the barn owner confirming satisfactory completion through Tobacco Board.
5. The tenderer will invariably submit item wise cost as specified in Column.6 of tender application form. The tenderers will strictly adhere to specification mentioned in Sl.No.6 of the tender application form. Any deviation will make the supplier liable to replace the ventury furnace.
6. Payment will be made at the respective auction platforms on production of bill along with the consent letter and completion certificate obtained from the respective farmers/his representative at the time of execution of the work. Payment will not be made without consent letter and completion certificate from the respective farmers/his representative.
7. The latest copy of statement of Income Tax returns shall be enclosed without fail along with PAN number and a photo copy of the PAN card.
8. Wherever, the tenderer downloads the tender application from the Tobacco Board website, they should submit a DD for Rs.520/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore duly along with their tender forms.
9. The tenderer shall submit a DD for Rs.20,000/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore towards EMD along with tender form.
10. The successful tenderers are required to submit a DD for Rs.50,000/- drawn in favour of Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore towards security deposit for giving work order by the Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore.

11. Application without EMD will summarily be rejected.
12. The EMD and Security Deposit will not carry any interest and will be returned only after completion of execution of work by the successful tenderers.
13. The EMD and Security Deposit will be forfeited if the work of the successful tenderer is not satisfactory.
14. The EMD amount will be returned to the un-successful tenderers through post to the address mentioned in the tender application.
15. The finalized price of each unit will be in force for a period of One year from the date of work order.
16. The Board with the objective of completing the installation of Venturi furnaces in all the total barns within the stipulated time, may entrust the work to one or more agencies or may reduce the number of barns entrusted for installation of Venturi furnace in case if the progress of work found slow based on contingencies.
17. Wherever farmers prefer to use some existing items in the fixation of Venturi furnace in their barns i.e., fire bars, cast iron pipe, firebricks etc., proportionate cost of these items will be deducted from the payment due to the agency, which executed the work. In some cases, farmers also may supply the required bricks, sand, cement, red soil etc. The cost of these materials need to be reimbursed to the concerned grower by the designated agency/agencies.
18. Therefore, the tenderers have to invariably submit the cost of each item mentioned at item no 6. of the tender application form. The designated agency also shall accordingly raise the bill excluding the cost of items reused and the items supplied by the grower. The FA/FO/SGO/Auction Superintendent of auction platform of the Board also would verify these matters with the concerned growers at the time of inspection of the barns fitted with Venturi furnace and recommend for release of payment accordingly.
19. Wherever the farmers dig the pit required for fixing the Venturi furnace and the designated agency shall reimburse the labour charges for one or two labourers engaged by the farmers for this purpose.
20. The agency also shall submit a statement of list of barns size wise with name of the grower, TBGRs/TB no. of the concerned barns village wise to the concerned APFs.
21. The successful tenderer has to transport the required Ventury furnace material to the barn site at his own cost. The Board is not responsible for any loss of items during transit (or) at barn site.
22. The tenderer shall submit a separate tender form for fixing venturi furnace in the barns and superscribing on the covers "tender for fixing ventury furnace". The sealed covers shall be dropped in the tender box kept at Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore, before 3.00 PM on

30/5/08. Tenders will be opened at 4.00PM on the same day in the presence of tenderers.

23. The list of barns village wise and APF wise is available with the Regional Manager, Tobacco Board, Mysore.
24. The work relating to fixation of ventury furnace in the barns is required to be carried in the jurisdiction of APFs H.D.Kote,Hunsur I &II, Periyapatna-4,5,&6, Kampalapura - I&II in Mysore district and Ramanathapura I&II in Hassan District.
25. The Chairman, Tobacco Board, Guntur, has every right to reject any/all tenders without assigning any reasons.

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
